While we have provided this simple worship aid for you, a more detailed worship aid with the readings will be available on our website and Facebook page.

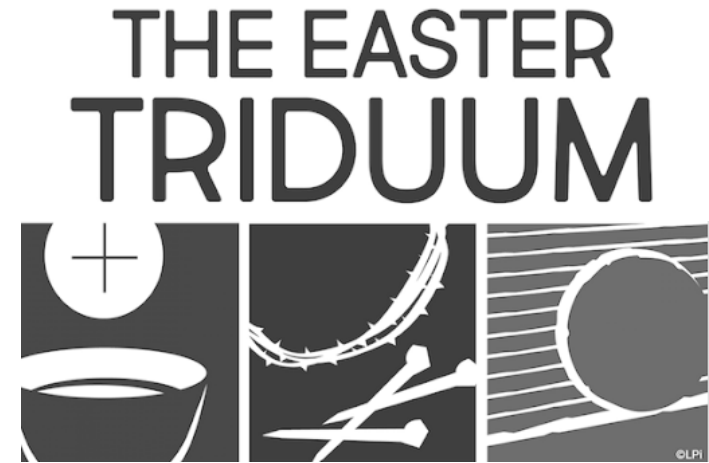

Holy Thursday: Mass of the Lord's Supper
Thursday, April 9th, 7:00pm

Entrance Hymn: Lift High the Cross

Refrain: Lift high the cross, the love of Christ proclaim till all the world adore his sacred name.

Verse 1: Led on their way by this triumphant sign, the hosts of God in conquering ranks combine. (Refrain)

Verse 2: Each newborn servant of the Crucified Bears on the brow the seal of him who died. (Refrain)

First Reading: Exodus 12:1-8, 11-14

Responsorial Psalm: Our Blessing cup is a communion with the blood of Christ.

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 11:23-26

Gospel Acclamation: Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ, King of endless glory!

Gospel: John 13: 1-15

Presentation Hymn: We Remember

Refrain: We remember how you loved us to your death, and still we celebrate for you are with us here; And we believe that we will see you when you come in your glory, Lord. We remember, we celebrate we believe.

Verse 1: Here, a million wounded souls are yearning just to touch you and be healed. Gather all your people, and hold them to your heart. (Refrain)

Verse 2: Now we recreate your love, we bring the bread and wine to share a meal. Sign of grace and mercy, the presence of the Lord. (Refrain)

First Reading: Acts of the Apostles 10:34a,37-43

Responsorial Psalm: This is the day the Lord has made, let us rejoice and be glad.

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 5:6b-8

Easter Sequence: Christ, The Lord, Is Risen Today

Verse 1: Christ, the Lord, is ris'n today; Christians, haste your vows to pay; Make your joy and praises known, At the Paschal Victim's throne; For the sheep the Lamb has bled, Sinless in the sinner's stead; Christ the Lord is ris'n on high; Now he lives no more to die.

Verse 2: Christ, the Victim undefiled, God and sinners reconciled: when in strange and awesome strife, Met together death and life; Christians, on this happy day, Haste with joy your vows to pay; Christ, the Lord is risen on high; Now he lives no more to die!

Renewal of Baptism Promises

Sprinkling Rite: I saw water flowing from the right side of the temple, Alleluia! Alleluia!

Presentation Hymn: Ye Sons and Daughters (see page 5)

Memorial Acclamation: We proclaim your Death, O Lord, and process your Resurrection until you come again.

Communion Hymn: At The Lamb's High Feast (see page 6)

Recessional Hymn: Christ is Risen From the Dead

Communion Hymn: At The Lamb's High Feast

Verse 1: At the Lamb's high feast we sing, praise to our victorious King, He has washed us in the tide, Flowing from his wounded side: Praise we him whose love divine, Gives his sacred Blood for wine, Gives his Body for the feast, Christ the victim, Christ the priest.

Verse 2: Where the Paschal blood is poured, Death's dark angel sheathes his sword; Israel's hosts triumphant go, Through the wave that drowns the foe. Praise we Christ whose blood was shed, Paschal victim, Paschal bread; With sincerity and love, eat we manna from above.

Recessional Hymn: Christ is Risen From the Dead

Verse 1: Christ is Risen from the dead, Risen as He truly said; Praise the Lord with grateful voice, Bless His name, rejoice, rejoice!

Verse 2: Angels clad in snowy white, Coming from the realms of light, Bid us sing with grateful voice, Bid us all rejoice, rejoice!

Easter Sunday

Sunday, April 12th, 9:00am

Entrance Hymn: Jesus Christ Is Risen Today

Verse 1: Jesus Christ is ris'n today, Alleluia! Our triumphant holy day, Alleluia! Who did once upon the cross, Alleluia! Suffer to redeem our loss. Alleluia!

Verse 2: Hymns of praise then let us sing, Alleluia! Unto Christ our heavenly King, Alleluia! Who endured the cross and grave, Alleluia! Sinners to redeem and save, Alleluia!

Memorial Acclamation: When we eat this Bread and drink this Cup, we proclaim your Death, O Lord, until you come again.

Communion Hymn: Lord, Who At Thy First Eucharist

Verse 1: At that first Eucharist before you died, O Lord, you prayed that all be one in you; At this our Eucharist again preside, And in our hearts your law of love renew. O may we all one bread, one body be, Through this blest Sacrament of Unity.

Verse 2: For all thy Church, O Lord, we intercede; Make thou our sad divisions soon to cease; Draw us the nearer each, to each we plead, By drawing all to thee, O Prince of Peace; Thus may we all one bread, one body be, Through this blest Sacrament of Unity.

Gospel: The Passion of the Lord: John 18:1-19:42

The Solemn Intercessions

Procession of the Holy Cross: Come, let us adore

Veneration of the Cross: Behold the Wood of the Cross

Refrain: Behold, behold the wood of the cross, on which is hung our salvation. O come, let us adore.

Verse 1: Unless a grain of wheat shall fall upon the ground and die, it shall remain but a single grain and not give life.

(Refrain)

Verse 2: And when my hour of glory comes as all was meant to be, you shall see me lifted up upon a tree.

(Refrain)

Communion Hymn: O Sacred Head, Surrounded

Verse 1: O Sacred Head, surrounded by crown of piercing thorn! O bleeding Head, so wounded, Reviled and put to scorn! The pow'r of death comes o'er you, the glow of life decays, yet angel hosts adore you, and tremble as they gaze.

Verse 2: In this, your bitter passion, Good Shepherd, think of me. With your most kind compassion, Unworthy though I be: Beneath your cross abiding, Forever would I rest, in your dear love confiding, and with your presence blest.
